THE PRINCESS ALEXANDRA AUDITORIUM

The 750-seat Auditorium has been designed and built to the highest performance specifications. The facility was opened in 2013 and has hosted numerous high-profile performers, such as Heather Small, Rob Beckett and Colin Baker. The London Gospel Choir, The London Festival Opera and many more. The facility has also been awarded two prestigious RIBA awards for design excellence.



THE FRIARAGE THEATRE

The Friarage Theatre has been built to the same standards as the Princess Alexandra Auditorium but provides a more intimate space with 140 seats. The HD projector and surround sound mean it is the perfect venue for National Theatre Live and RSC Live. Friarage Theatre is located next to the School reception (white building).
